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Synopsis

Based on true events ANGELO tells the story of the African born Angelo Soliman, who was taken by force from his homeland at a very young age in the beginning of the early 18th century.

After surviving the long involuntary journey across the Atlantic, an African boy is sold to a European countess who turns him into the object of an educational experiment. For his next owner, a noble duke, Angelo changes into a costumed story-telling valet, reciting stories about mysterious Africa to entertain an enlightened high-society, until he attracts the attention of the emperor.

On the height of his prestige, he falls in love with a young maidservant but inevitably suffers the rejection from the court that has to draw a strict line between racial differences.

Short Version

In early 18th century an African slave boy is chosen by a European Comtesse to be baptized and educated. Reaching adulthood, Angelo achieves prominence and soon becomes the Viennese court mascot until he decides to secretly marry a white woman. Based on true events.



Director's Statement

At the beginning of the 18th century a young boy is being taken away from his African home, brought to Europe and put up there on sale as a slave. Still he is comparatively well off, as he is purchased by nobles as their blackamoor.

But for the rest of his life not ever again will he meet anyone who either talks his mother tongue or is able to keep alive the memories of his origins - his source.

But as man, as I see it, cannot exist without his very

own place in life, be it big or small, assimilated or autonomous, our boy smartly and proudly begins to do everything to please and to conquer and fill in the place allegedly offered to him.

Strangely enough, this seems to work best in As for me the story of the black skin is a mere passiveness and silence.

For often it is the vague that offers greater possibility to mirror the counterpart.

So ANGELO for me turns out to be a story about. That is where I find myself. limitation and the desire of "the other" for


embourgeoisement and dissolution into mass and standard. A tale about getting tired of being different. A discourse about acceptance and tolerance.
