After going blind again,
Maria Theresia von Paradis began to compose music.

Her concert tours led her to Berlin, Brussels, London, Paris, Prague, and other cities across Europe.

A dedicated music educator and founder of a music school for the blind, she died in Vienna in 1824, aged 64.

Of her numerous songs, operas, and instrumental compositions, only a few have been preserved to this day.
