# SHORT SYNOPSIS

At the turn of the 20th century, the young orphan Andreas is sent to live with his ruthless uncle on a farm in a remote valley; a valley that Andreas will only leave once in his life. Treated not as family but as a worker, Andreas endures a childhood without affection, full of brutality and hard labour. At the age of 18, Andreas has seen only hardship but finds the courage to leave his oppressor. Though partly crippled by his uncle, he has grown into a strong man and finds work as a woodsman. He works on the construction of an invention: the mountain ropeway. This invention marks the beginning of alpine tourism but is paid for with the many deaths of mountain workers. Andreas is no stranger to hard labour, and now that he is earning his own money, he buys himself a small plot of land with a cabin high up in the valley. He soon finds something he has never experienced before: love. Marie immediately becomes the light of his life, but his dream of a happy life together is soon shattered. Feeling despondent, Andreas enlists as a soldier in the German Wehrmacht. Coming face to face with death in the Russian Caucasus, he thinks only of Marie. Having survived the madness of the second World War, Andreas returns to the valley and to a changed world. With Marie always in his heart, Andreas accepts and cherishes the time he has left with serenity.

The author Robert Seethaler is also a screenwriter and actor. His novel THE TOBACCONIST and screenplay MY MOTHER, MY BRIDE AND I were both adapted into feature films. The latter marked his first collaboration with director Hans Steinbichler.

# DIRECTOR

Hans Steinbichler grew up in Southern Bavaria and studied directing at the Munich Film School. His debut feature HIERANKL (2003), starring Johanna Wokalek and Barbara Sukova, was the recipient of numerous awards. Hans' second feature WINTER JOURNEY (Winterreise -2005), starring Sibel Kekili and Hannah Schygulla, premiered in official competition at the Karlovy Vary International Film Festival and was nominated for Best Feature Film at the German Film Awards. With MY MOTHER, MY BRIDE AND I (Die Zweite Frau – 2007), Hans premiered the film at the Toronto International Film Festival and won the prestigious Grimme-Price for film direction for a second time. After PROMISING THE MOON (Das Blaue vom Himmel – 2011) which was awarded the Best Film at the Bayarian Film Awards, Hans received a call from the International Film School Cologne (ifs) to teach direction. He returned to feature filmmaking in 2016 with THE DIARY OF ANNE FRANK (Das Tagebuch der Anne Frank), starring Lea van Acken and Martina Gedeck. The film received its world premiere at the Berlinale Film Festival and won Hans the German Metropolis Directing Award, which he received again 2 years later for THE UNHEARD WOMEN (Eine unerhörte Frau - 2018). Next to his work as a feature director Hans has also directed for Television, most recently directing the third season of the Television Remake of DAS BOOT. With A WHOLE LIFE (Ein ganzes Leben – 2023), Hans is taking on the adaptation of the bestselling novel that is published around the world.
